

BANK OF MALDIVES TO DONATE 33 MOTORISED WHEELCHAIRS TO SUPPORT PEOPLE WITH MOBILITY IMPAIRMENTS

Bank of Maldives continues to support people with mobility impairments across the Maldives with a donation of additional 33 motorised wheelchairs.

With this donation, the program which began in 2017 has now seen the successful delivery of over 200 motorised wheelchairs across the Maldives, enhancing the quality of life for people living with physical disabilities.

The wheelchair donation program has been instrumental in improving the lives of so many disabled people and their families.
