

BML SUPPORTS COMMUNITY IN FARES MATHODA WITH NEW ATM

Bank of Maldives has opened a new Self Service ATM in GDh. Fares Mathoda as part of its commitment to supporting local communities.

In addition to the usual cash withdrawal facilities, the new ATM will support local individuals and businesses to deposit and transfer money on a 24/7 basis. It is part of the Bank's MVR 300 million investment program to expand banking services and financial inclusion across the country. The facility was officially inaugurated by Director of BML Islamic, Zulkarnain Bin Taman, at a ceremony held on the island today.
